The projects in her division centre on the dena Grid Study II, power plant planning, the development of offshore wind energy, energy specific research papers about the integration of renewable energies into the energy system, the intelligent coordination of electricity generation and demand (Smart Meter, Smart Grid, Smart System), top runner strategies for energy efficiency standards, the EU's Energy Services Directive and the development of innovative energy services.
