William D. Drake was born on October 22, 1941 and graduated from Dickinson College with a Bachelor of Science in Anthropology in 1965. He then attended graduate school at the University of Cincinnati from 1968 until 1969.

Mr. Drake served as a Peace Corps Volunteer in Tchad from 1965 until 1967. He also taught in both the Caribbean and the US through the Head Start Program. Then in 1981, Mr. Drake founded the Santa Fe Natural Tobacco Company, which developed a market for natural tobacco produced by Native Americans on tribal lands. In 1990, he founded CultureBanc.com, an online cross-cultural training company. From 1995 to 1997, Mr. Drake acted as a computer-based training developer and international management consultant to the non-profit Centre for International Business Studies, in Amstelveen, The Netherlands. He also acted as an adjunct Professor of International Management at the University of Texas at Dallas, Graduate School of Management, from 1997 through 1999.

Currently, Mr. Drake works as a writer/publisher in the fields of bioenergy research and cross-cultural studies, as well as a video and television producer, corporate trainer, and CBT developer. He is married and has one adult child.
